



Disconnect your sander from it's power source.

1. Trim the COLLAR (1) so that the SKIRT (2) of the Dust Muzzle extends 1/16 to 1/8 inch beyond the surface of the ABRASIVE DISK (3).

The easiest way to trim the collar is by making a continuous 1/8" spiral cut, counter clockwise with an ordinary scissors until you reach the desired COLLAR (1)_length. If you trim more than 1/8" you may cause a stress crack. The COLLAR (1) may also be trimmed using 60 grit sandpaper on a stationary or belt sander, a DremelTM tool, a hot knife or a fine (32 tooth) metal cutting hacksaw blade. Do not use a shears or a box knife to trim the collar.

- 2. Attach the Dust Muzzle to your grinder with the HOSE CLAMP (4), provided.
- 3. Attach the VACUUM HOSE (5) to the Dust Muzzle and secure the hose to the grinder near the handle with the RELEASEABLE CABLE TIE (6), provided.
